

OSGOODE VS. ARGONAUT.

Toronto, October 29.—Osgoode and Argonaut met for the second and last time this season on the Rosedale grounds this afternoon, when the oarsmen again went down before the Legalites, to the tune of 17 to 8, the score at half-time being 6 to 2. The day was an ideal one for the game, but the crowd was small, there not being more than 500 in attendance.

Shortly after the scheduled time, the match commenced, and was a fairly good exhibition of Rugby. Both teams put up a harder game than they have heretofore. It was not pretty to watch at times, as the play, instead of being open, was close, and there was a lot of scrummaging, both teams keeping the ball well in hand. The Osgoode team was somewhat altered since these two teams met last, for Gleeson made his initial appearance on the back line, taking charge of the team and showing great generalship. The two scrimmages were well matched, while, if anything, the Legalites were strongest on the wing line.
