

"TIGERS" WON.

Whitewashed Argonauts on Saturday.

TORONTO, November 14.—The Argonauts were beaten in the last senior Rugby match of the season on Bloor street grounds on Saturday afternoon by Hamilton Tigers, partly by hard luck and partly by better play, by 14 to 0, the score at half-time being 6 to 0. The snow made it almost impossible to scrimmage or catch the ball and consequently a lot of fumbling was done by both teams all through the game. The score by no means indicates the character of the games, as 2 or 3 tries were gotten by good luck more than good management and besides this, the oarsmen had the best of the game all through the first half and most of the second. When it came near the finish there was some dispute between the timers, but that was fixed to the satisfaction of both teams. The day was not an ideal one and the game dragged along, being livened up by an occasional set-to by the players and by the small boys throwing snowballs at the stand, which was poorly filled.
