

ASSOCIATION TEAM IS BACK FROM COWVILLE

Y. M. C. A. Boys Say Game Was Cleanest Ever Played in Calgary—Out-Played Rough Riders in Every Department of the Game—Play Tigers Coming Saturday.

The Y. M. C. A. team returned from Calgary yesterday afternoon highly elated over their win from the Calgary Rough Riders in the southern burg on Saturday, by 11 to 1. They state that the game was one of the cleanest ever played in Calgary, not a man being ruled off during the entire game and scarcely a dispute arising. The boys had the Calgary team outclassed in every department of the game as the score 11 to one indicates. The line was like a stone wall, the Calgary fellows scarcely gaining a yard while in the first quarter the Edmonton line shoved them over more than eight yards.

In the first quarter the Edmonton team scored three points and in the second period a try which they converted, and followed it up in a few minutes with a rouge. In the third period the Calgary bunch got busy and shoved a kick over the dead line and near the end of the game Edmonton again made a point.

The play was open throughout and the Association had the Rough Riders outrun and outclassed.

The result of the game has given the men confidence in their ability and they are satisfied they will defeat the Tigers next Saturday when that famous aggregation comes here to play.
