

Alta. 'Varsity Squad Defeats 63rd Battalion

EDMONTON, Alta., Oct. 11.—Alberta University, winner of senior provincial honors last season, defeated a strong team from the 63rd Battalion in an exhibition game of rugby here this afternoon, before a large crowd, by a score of 24 to 7. The soldiers got away in the lead, scoring seven points before 'Varsity got going, Cameron going the length of the field for a touchdown after blocking a kick. 'Varsity pulled up on even terms before half-time, and in the last two periods had a decided advantage of the play.

Pilgrim, with Queen's University last year, was the star of the game, scoring three touchdowns, while Perraton, who also scintillated all afternoon, accounted for the other. 'Varsity has a heavy team, and a better back division than last season, so will give the Calgary Canucks a real argument when these teams meet for the Alberta championship in Edmonton next Saturday.
