

Eskimos Should Win From Tigers This Afternoon On Showing Against Hamilton

The Calgary Tigers headed by Coach Joe Price invaded Edmonton this morning, arriving by the 8 o'clock train from the south prepared to do stern battle with the Edmonton Eskimos in the opening game of the Alberta Rugby association. The old red-hot inter-city rivalry will be on tap and there promises to be an even larger crowd than that which witnessed last week's clash with the Hamilton Tigers. If the results of the two games with the easterners can be taken as any indication, then Deacon White's warriors should have little difficulty in disposing of their southern rivals, as the Esks held the Hamiltonians to a 15-3 count while Calgary was literally smothered by a 36-9 count. The fact must not be overlooked, however, that Calgary managed to score as many points against Liz Marriott's stars as the Eskimos and Regina combined, and rumor has it that Joe Price has a much stronger team than that which stacked up against Hamilton.

The Eskimos held their final workout at Diamond park last evening and showed worlds of pep and speed. The gang is primed to the minute and well fortified with substitutes. The whistle will sound at 3 o'clock, sending the teams into action, and it's a safe bet that the result will go a long way toward deciding the 1921 Alberta championship. Shibley Cormack of Edmonton, and Arnold Wark of Calgary, will probably be the officials.
