

PARKDALES LOSE TO QUEEN'S, 18-13

KINGSTON, Oct. 15.—The Queen's University rugby team scored their second straight win of the present season when they trimmed the Toronto Parkdales at the new Stadium this afternoon by a score of 18 to 13. Ideal weather prevailed and a record crowd greeted the two twelves when they took the field.

The play was very even in the first half and the rest found the students in front by 5 to 4, but in the final half they struck their stride and piled up an additional total of thirteen points while the Parkdales were getting nine. Play was clean throughout and some brilliant work was shown by both teams, the back field work of the Parkdales standing out in particular. The Queen's trio played a clever game behind the lines and both defences afforded plenty of protection.

Breen was the pivot of the Parkdale attack and Bevan and Burt shone as ground gainers on the close work. Campbell was in the lime light for Queens and was backed up in fine style by his line.

There was only one point scored in the first period, when Breen, of Parkdale, kicked to the dead line just before time was called. Parkdale 1, Queens 0.

In the second period Breen kicked a pretty field goal. Parkdale 4, Queens 0.

Following this Parkdale's line failed to hold, and was pushed back to Parkdale five-yard line. Carroll ripped around the end for a touch which was not converted. Queens 5, Parkdale 4.

Half time came without further scoring.

In the third quarter McLeod was downed for a point. Queens 5, Parkdale 5.

Queens then made a point when Goddard was downed. Queens 6, Parkdale 5.

Evans picked up a loose ball and passed to McKay who went over for a touch which was converted. Queens 12, Parkdale 5.

In the fourth quarter Campbell went over for a touch which he converted. Queens 18, Parkdale 5.

Breen retaliated by also going over for a touch which was converted. Queens 18, Parkdale 11.

The visitors added two more on a safety touch before the final time was called.

Final score: Queens 18, Parkdale 13.
