

**PARKDALES AGAIN
WIN FROM TORONTO**

**Final Score Was 17 To 7 In
Favor of Paddlers.**

TORONTO, Oct. 23. — Toronto's run of bad luck was still with them in the senior O.R.F.U. game at Varsity stadium, on Saturday, when they lost to the Parkdale paddlers by a score of 17 to 7.

When the game was called 10 minutes early to make way for the rugger exhibition match the score stood 7 to 6 in favor of the Torontos. Then the team went out to finish during the ruggers' half time interval, and in the 10 minutes the Parkdales waded in and added 11 points to their credit. Torontos fought well in their three games this season until the breaks went against them, and then they faded.

Parkdale started the game like world beaters, and Munro soon booted for a rouge, and against the wind, and a few minutes later one of Coutie's kicks was blocked on the Toronto 25-yard line, and Douglas went across for a try. This was all the scoring in the first period, but the black and white were gradually improving on the offensive.

The onslaught of the Torontos on the Parkdale line in the third period was a treat. Time after time the tall-enders flung themselves at the opposing line and invariably they gained. They started off well when on the kick-off Coutie booted behind the Parkdale goal line and Munro was forced to rouge by Waldron. Parkdale was caught asleep when Torontos scored their try. On almost every occasion when Torontos needed a couple of yards on the third down Eddie Garnett tried a delayed dash through the centre, and was always successful.

In the fourth period Torontos continued their bucking tactics, and gained repeatedly. With the exception of the first 10 and the last 10 minutes the losers were the better team.
