

Vancouver Outscores Champions

Victoria Rugby Squad Fights Hard But Are Beaten 8-0 at Home

VICTORIA, Oct. 24.—Superior in every department of the game, Vancouver defeated a badly crippled Victoria team 8-0 in a grimly-fought battle in the "Big Four" Canadian Rugby league at the Royal Athletic park Saturday afternoon.

The Victoria gridders fought desperately every inch of the way, with the result that the visitors were unable to cross the locals' goal line for a try.

Vancouver scored all their points from kicks, a field goal and a rouge in the first quarter, a rouge in the second quarter and a second field goal about three minutes before the final whistle.

The high wind blowing in the first quarter helped the visitors to score their first four points.
