

Victoria Beaten 12-6 in Canadian Rugby Game

VICTORIA, Oct. 8.—U. C. T., Victoria's representatives in the "Big Four" Canadian' Rugby league, went down to a 12-6 defeat at the hands of Vancouver Saturday afternoon in the opening game played at the Royal Athletic park.
