

SARNIA IMPERIALS WIN OVER VARSITY

Western Section Senior O. R. F. U. Leaders End Schedule by 6-0 Victory

Sarnia, Ont., November 6.—The Sarnia Imperials finished the senior O. R. F. U. schedule undefeated when they blanked the Varsity Orphans 6 to 0 before a crowd of 1,500 at Athletic Park here this afternoon. It was their sixth successive victory.

Many of the regulars were missing from both line-ups, but the second string gridlers turned in good performances and it was a keen contest despite the fact that it had no bearing on the group title.

Sarnia's points were registered in the first two periods. Two minutes before the end of the first quarter, Warren playing quarter for the Imperials kicked from Varsity's 35-yard line. McCullough standing within the shadow of the visitors' goal post muffed the catch and Ewener, coming down fast, fell on the ball just over the line for a touchdown. McPhedran failed to convert.

Sarnia's lone point in the second period came when McPhedran booted from his own 45-yard line. The ball bounded high and rolled across the line before Scott could grab it and Warren forced the Varsity receiver to rouge.

L. Perry, Ewoner and Warren were the pick of the Sarnia twelve, while Henderson, Richardson and Levinsky were standouts for Var-sity.
