

Eskis Trim Students 11 To 0

EDMONTON, Oct. 9.—Edmonton Eskimos chalked up their first win of the season when they defeated University of Alberta 11-0 here Saturday in an Alberta Rugby Football Union fixture, the second game in the capital this season. The victory put the Calgary Altomahs in an opportunity-laden position to win the Alberta championship.

The Eskimos opened the scoring early in the first quarter when Eric Dolighan's attempted field goal went to the deadline for a point. Shortly afterwards Horne intercepted a Varsity forward pass and raced 30 yards for the first touchdown, which went unconverted.

The second and third quarters went scoreless but the Eskimos cinched the victory in the fourth when Clayton Dolighan followed up fast on his brother's punt to Al Hall, jarring the ball loose from the Varsity half-back and falling on it for the second touchdown.

While the students showed strong defensive measures at times, their offensive was weak and most of the play was in their territory.
