

## 700 Fans Witness Game in Lethbridge

LETHBRIDGE, Oct. 9.—Steady but slow rugby football marked the league fixture Saturday afternoon at Adams park here between the University of Alberta and the Bulldogs. The score was 6-3 in favor of the Varsity and indicates the evenly matched setup of the squads. Seven hundred fans saw the encounter.

The Varsity pulled several extension runs that netted them 10 yards each time. Scott and Richard carrying the ball. Varsity started a drive in the second quarter with Malcolm, Rule and Richard carrying the ball. They had a fake "hip" that pulled Lethbridge offside again and again to give them 10-yard penalties. Len Parks, burly Varsity middle, was pulled out of the line and made yards twice on bucks. He made a good showing. The first half ended 5-3, Richard throwing a forward and the Lethbridge left half was caught napping, letting Morton receive the oval and race for a touchdown.

The second half opened with Varsity kicking to the Bulldogs goal-line. Bloomfield made a sensational 60-yard kick to put the ball back to centre. Varsity was ripping holes in the Lethbridge line and made yards twice on bucks. The game proceeded with nothing thrilling to the crowd. With two minutes to go Hamilton was injured and the Lethbridge's chances to equalize faded and the final count was Varsity 6, Lethbridge 3.
