

North Shore Lions Trounce Meralomas

VANCOUVER, Nov. 22 (C.P.)—North Shore Lions held the Big Four Canadian Football League leadership today after a smashing 18-1 decision over Vancouver Meralomas here Saturday.

Pete Modine plunged over for a touchdown in the first quarter, and Harry Bullock added a field goal in the second after Bus Haugh punted to the deadline for Meraloma's lone point.

Bullock fired a 20-yard forward pass to Johnny Smith, who galloped another 20 for a third quarter touchdown, and tossed a 15-yarder to Smith waiting over the Meralomas goal line in the fourth to end the scoring.

None of the touchdowns was converted.
