

Eskimos Thrill Fans At Home

BUT BRONKS WIN CLOSE GAME 5-3

EDMONTON, Sept. 26. — Calgary Bronks' forward pass attack clicked when it was needed Saturday and Carl Cronin's gridders edged out Edmonton Eskimos 5-3 in a hard-fought Western Canada Football conference game that was scoreless until halfway through the final quarter.

In earlier conference games Bronks' most apparent weakness was their lack of a ground-gaining aerial offensive but they uncovered two forward formations on consecutive plays for 39 yards Saturday to break a deadlock late in the game against a much-improved Edmonton team.

Great Rally

Bronks, weakened by absence of Quarterback Bob Campbell, Guard Bob Harrison and Middle Cecil Holmes, counted on a placement, a rouge and a kick. Edmonton scored a placement.

Eskimos cheered about 2,000 Edmonton fans with their great display, featured by a 54-yard charge in the third quarter that brought them inside of the Calgary 15-yard line. The big break of the game ended the march there.

Halfback Steve Olander, last year with Winnipeg, fumbled when tackled by Jack Lawrence, Calgary inside, and Bronks' classy running half, Johnny Mike Sullivan, picked up the ball.

Bronks opened the scoring after they blocked a kick deep in Edmonton territory and grabbed the ball. Ed Rorvig, Calgary's hefty fullback, then kicked a placement for three points.

A few minutes later Edmonton tied the count when Sutton kicked a field goal from 18 yards out. A Calgary fumble, recovered by Edmonton, put Eskimos in a position to score those points.

Passes Help

With only a few minutes left to break the deadlock, Bronks showed they were dangerous in the air. Calgary moved the yardsticks 19 yards on Halfback Paul Rowe's forward to Sullivan and the latter pitched the ball 20 yards to End Keith Gibson on the next play. Flying Wing Buzzard kicked back of the Edmonton goal-line and Sutton was brought down for a point.
