

# Hamilton Wildcats On Rampage To Defeat Kitchener Panthers

**Ambitious City Team Virtually Clinches O.R.F.U. Crown by Handing Panthers 39-7 Defeat. Al Lenard, Scotty Wright, George Slinn and Teddy Manorek Lead Hamilton Team to Victory.**

HAMILTON, Ont., Oct. 19—(C.P.) — There's lots of class in Hamilton's football club this year but how much will not be answered until they meet either Ottawa Rough Riders or Toronto Argonauts in the Eastern Canada finals some time next month.

The Wildcats were turned loose against Kitchener-Waterloo Panthers Saturday and at the end of the struggle they were on top, 39-7, with the Senior Ontario Rugby Football Union title virtually in their grasp.

Their star-studded backfield, paced by the long distance passing of Al Lenard, the kicking of Scotty Wright and George Slinn and the plunging of Teddy Manorek, was too good for the inexperienced Panthers as they turned on a blistering attack. That offensive really got going in the final half when they gathered in 25 points after being on top, 14-7, at the end of the first two quarters.

#### Panthers Fade.

In the first half Panthers tried desperately to keep pace with the Wildcats and at one time Hamilton was ahead only by three points, 9-6. But before the half-time whistle blew Manorek picked up a touchdown and after that they were never headed.

The Wildcats crossed the line for six touchdowns. Manorek snatched two and Jim Fumio, Slinn, Howard Awrey and L. Anthony went over for the other major scores. Lenard kicked four single points, two of which were conversions of touchdowns, and a field goal. The other Hamilton points were taken by Wright and Howard Awrey with single point kicks.

Red Gilbert paced the Panthers, kicking a fine game although he lacked line support which enabled the Wildcats to smash through and break up some of his kicks. The only Kitchener points came from a fumble in the second quarter when Bonner picked up the ball to run unmolested for a touchdown that Coach Busher

Young converted and a single kicked by Gilbert.
