

## BALMY BEACH WINS IN O.R.F.U. CLASH

## Jakubowski and Smythe Are Standouts in 34-0 Rout of Panthers

Toronto, October 11. — (C) — A couple of speedy halfbacks, freshly out of high school—Edmond Jakubowski and pocket-sized Ken Smythe—paid off richly in scoring points Saturday as Toronto Balmy Beach, striking hard through the air, outclassed Kitchener-Waterloo Panthers 34-0 in the second game of an Ontario Rugby Football Union double-header before 7,000 fans.

Jakubowski and Smythe personally took almost sole charge of the scoring, achieving five touchdowns between them on long passes from Bobby Porter and Joe Bailey. Outside Leo Deadey fell on a loose ball behind the Panther goal-line to complete the scoring.

The season's first success for Beaches moved them into a fourth-place deadlock with Toronto Oakwood Indians, partially salvaged the sting of last week's humiliating 40-6 reverse by R.C.A.F. Hurricanes and marked the possible beginning of a long, hard haul to the playoffs.

Panthers, victims of the third shutout on Saturday's triple-barreled O.R.F.U. program, never were in striking distance as they lost their third straight game to sink deep into the cellar. Their wingline yielded little to Beaches, but in the open field and through the air they were vastly outplayed. Doug Smith's long booting and Gus Schelers' runbacks were their best offensive weapons.

Jakubowski, former track and field star at Toronto's Harbord Collegiate, scored three of the Beach touchdowns.
