

Beach Wins

Toronto Indians Their Victims by Score of 21 to 10

TORONTO, Oct. 25.—Toronto Balmy Beach remained within striking distance of an Ontario Rugby Football Union play-off berth Saturday by defeating Toronto Indians 21-10 for their fourth victory in six starts.

SELKIRK SHINES

Selkirk scored all the Indian points, converting his own first-quarter touchdown and kicking a field goal and single in the third quarter. His one-man stand was futile as Chad Bark, Ross McKelvey, Sammy Sward, Stu Scott and Annis and Frank Stukus powered the Beach machine for long gains.

McKelvey opened the scoring for Beaches in the first quarter and converted his own touchdown. Indians knotted the count when Selkirk snatched a Beach fumble deep in enemy territory and plunged on second down for a touchdown.

PLACEMENT BY STUKUS

A placement by Annis Stukus and a long forward from Annis to Outside Leo Deadey made it 15-6 in the second quarter. Deadey carried the 30-yard toss eight yards for a major score and Annis Stukus, the loop's leading scorer, converted. Bark, one of the longest ground gainers for either team, added a fourth-quarter touchdown which was converted on a forward from Frank Stukus to Deadey.
