

Bombers Annex Football Title

No. 3 Wireless Bombers annexed the Services Football league championship, Saturday, just as a lot of people thought they would.

The Bombers, who never lost a game all season, defeated Rivers Pathfinders, 15-5, Saturday in the second game of the total point series, winning the round, 26-12. The Bombers won the first game two weeks ago, 11-7.

There is talk of a playoff between the service champions of Manitoba and Ontario but nothing definite has been announced. Half-fax service teams also want to get into the series if it is to be staged, they say.

Several hundred fans sat through a dampish afternoon to see the Bombers outplay the air-men from No. 1 Central Navigation school. The Wireless school gridders had too much class and experience and a greatly superior line for the Rivers club.

Kippy McFadyen's early touchdown put Rivers behind ten points on the series early in the first period and after Gordon Clemons scored for Rivers in the second period, No. 3 pulled further away and spent most of the time in Rivers' half of the premises.

Dave Greenberg, Bill Dunsmore and Reg Harmer stood out in No. 3's backfield, while Clemons and Hank Meiers and Nick Staynor were Rivers' leading backs.

Bombers reached Rivers' 15 and 4-yard lines in the game's early stages without striking pay-dirt, but Greenberg tossed a 16-yard pass that McFadyen took on the four to race over the goal to open the scoring. Dave Berry kicked the extra point.

Early in the second period Clemons took a pass from Meier that covered 30 yards for a touchdown, but Meier's pass for the extra point went incomplete.

Greenberg's surprise return kick went 65 yards to the Broadway Ave. wall for another point before half-time. Big Dave added another touchdown in the fourth period after Bombers pushed their way from midfield and Barry added the extra point. Clemons was rouged when he fell in the end zone with Greenberg's punt and could get out in time for another point.

Clemons also was rouged by three Bombers for the other score.
