

O.R.F.U. Opens at Windsor

Windsor, Ont., September 16.—(C) —Hamilton Wildcats scored 18 points in a hectic third-quarter rally to start on the trail of their third consecutive Ontario Rugby Football Union championship when they defeated Windsor Rockets, 21-6, in the O.R.F.U. opener here Saturday.

Some 2,500 fans witnessed the contest, the first Senior O.R.F.U. game here in 14 years.

Windsor scored a touchdown in the second quarter when Lesensky recovered a blocked kick after Wildcats had scored three singles, two in the first quarter. Rockets held their 5-3 lead as the half ended.

The Champions turned on the power in the third quarter as Caperiotti, Wright and Seipi went for successive touchdowns, all of them converted.

Wright's touchdown provided the game's prettiest play as he knifed through the Windsor line on their 45 and went all the way for a major.

Windsor picked up the final point in the last quarter when Dyak was rouged on Lesensky's kick.

Wildcats picked up their first touchdown in the third quarter when their weight and experience began to tell. Lawson took a Windsor kick on his own 40 and later-alleged to Soyka who ran to the Windsor five, then passed to Guaracia who was downed on the one. Caperiotti then carried the ball over from scrimmage on the next play.

Seipi scored the last major for Hamilton after scooping up a blocked kick.

Caperiotti converted the first major and Wright the others.
