

## Indians Shade Beaches By 14-13 Count

TORONTO, Nov. 11.—(CP)—The Ontario Rugby Football Union closed its 62nd consecutive schedule Saturday as Toronto Indians shaded Toronto Balmy Beach, 14-13, in a playoff preview witnessed by about 4,000 fans in Maple Leaf Stadium.

The victory broke a first-place deadlock between the teams but the margin was so close that odds appeared about even for the home-and-home title series which opens at Maple Leaf Stadium Wednesday night. The second game will be played at Varsity Stadium next Saturday.
