Porter's Pass To Ford Ousts Hamilton Wildcats

HAMILTON, Oct. 21—(CP)—The deft passing arm of Halfback Bobby Porter turned defeat into victory here Saturday as Toronto Balmy Beach kept their share of first place in the Ontario Rugby Football Union by defeating Hamilton Wildcats, 11-8, after an uphill fight.

A crowd of about 8,000 saw Porter's forwards find their mark with deadly accuracy to set up one Beach touchdown and account directly for the other. The final fling came late in the last quarter and ousted Wildcats from all chance of a playoff berth.

Only team to beat the Beach this season, Wildcats seemed on their way to a repeat performance with an 8-5 lead in the final quarter. A fumble gave Toronto the offensive, however, and Porter singled out Tommy Ford in the clear for a 25-yard pass and Ford carried the ball over the line.
