Windsor football fans know today that the Senior O.R.F.U. is no "Sunday School" League, and the Hamilton Wildcats, defending champions of the circuit, no gridiron force to be regarded lightly. They found that out Saturday afternoon at Kennedy Stadium—at least 2,500 of them did—as they watched the Wildcats, trailing 5-3 at half time, lash out with a sustained third quarter drive that netted three rapid-fire touchdowns and a 21-6 triumph over Johnny Murray's Rockets in the first "Big Time" Canadian football game to be staged locally in 14 years.
