Mr. James Brooks Staton, 66, of 4 Chesterfield Court died Thursday, Sept. 16, 1993, at his home.

Funeral will be at 11 a.m. Saturday at Hanes-Lineberry North Elm Chapel. Burial will be in Green Hill Cemetery.

A life long resident of Greensboro, he was president of Jim Staton Distributing Co., and a Navy veteran of World War II. He attended Wake Forest University where he



was selected as the school's second All-American Football star and was inducted into the Wake Forest Sports Hall of Fame. He is a member of the North Carolina Sports Hall of Fame, and was voted All State in baseball and football in high school. He was drafted by the Boston Red Sox, but chose to play football with the Washington Redskins and Montreal in the Canadian Football League.

Surviving are wife, Mrs. Miriam Hancock Staton; daughter, Mrs. Martha Lynne Swaringen of Greensboro; sons, Mr. James B. Staton III, Mr. Michael A. Staton, both of Greensboro; grandchildren, Jennifer and Jonathan Staton, and Jim and Joe Swaringen.
