#### 1995 GAME REVIEWS - WEEK #1

# WEDNESDAY, JUNE 28 - WINNIPEG BLUE BOMBERS 15 AT OTTAWA ROUGH RIDERS 25 - 23,241

In the 1995 CFL season opener, the Winnipeg Blue Bombers travelled to the Nation's Capital to take on the Ottawa Rough Riders at Frank Clair Stadium. The Bombers went into this game as the heavy favourites, but much to the pleasure of the 23,241 fans in attendance, it was the Riders who emerged with a 25-15 victory. Winnipeg K Troy Westwood opened the scoring, connecting on a 48-yard field goal to give the Bombers an early 3-0 lead. Ottawa K Terry Baker got the Eastern Riders on the board with a single off a 53-yard missed FG attempt to make the score 3-1 in favour of Winnipeg at the end of one quarter of play. Ottawa QB Danny Barrett then took to the air hooking up with WR Odessa Turner for a 5-yard TD. Terry Baker added the convert to put the Riders up by 5. Westwood then narrowed the gap to 2 with a 33-yard FG before Baker countered with a 29 yarder of his own to make the score 11-6 Ottawa at the half. Baker gave the Riders a 12-6 lead with a 51-yard punting single and then widened the gap with an 18-yard FG. Barrett then scampered for an 18-yard TD. The Baker convert made the score 23-6 at the end of 3 quarters. Baker and Westwood traded FGs to open up the 4th quarter before Winnipeg QB Sammy Garza made it close by plunging over from 1-yard out. The 2-point convert attempt failed and this was as close as the Bombers would get making the final 25-15 in favour of the Eastern Riders.

## THURSDAY, JUNE 29 - MEMPHIS MAD DOGS 18 AT CALGARY STAMPEDERS 24 - 25,071

This game marked the first regular season CFL game for the expansion team from Memphis. Although the final outcome did not go in their favour, a message was sent to the rest of the CFL, "Beware of the Dogs". Led by former Edmonton Eskimo QB Damon Allen, the Mad Dogs came up a TD short, dropping a 24-18 decision to the Stampeders infront of 25,071 faithful fans at McMahon Stadium. K Chris Gardner recorded Memphis' first CFL point with a 40-yard single off a missed FG. The 1-point lead however was short-lived as Calgary QB Doug Flutie hooked up with SB Dave Sapunjis for a 3-yard TD strike at 8:27 of the opening frame. The Mark McLoughlin convert made it 7-1. Gardner redeemed himself, booting a 26-yard FG 3:00 minutes late to narrow the gap to just three at the end of a quarter of play. Allen then went to work connecting for a 50-yard pass and run play to WR Sam Horn. The Gardner convert gave the Mad Dogs their first lead of the game. A Tony Martino single narrowed the gap to 3 before McLoughlin would then tie it up with 8:36 gone in the second frame, this one from 33-yards out. He would then put the Stamps up with a 47 yarder, before Gardner and him traded FG's to bring the first half to a close with the Stamps clinging to a slim 3-point lead at 17-14. Calgary opened the second half scoring with another McLoughlin FG, this one from 49 yards out 2:29 into the third quarter. Gardner connected for his third FG of the night, a 25 yarder with 9:01 left in the third. Martino rounded out the third quarter scoring with a 40-yard punting single. McLoughlin booted his 5th FG of the night 4:26 into the fourth before Gardner added a single with 2:05 left to round out the scoring giving the Stamps a 24-18 victory.

## FRIDAY, JUNE 30 - HAMILTON TIGER-CATS 37 AT SASKATCHEWAN ROUGHRIDERS 16 - 23,396

For the football crazy fans of Taylor Field, this game marked the beginning of what many hope to be as the first game on the road to the Grey Cup, which is to be played there on November 19. However, the Hamilton Tiger-Cats were not about to steer a clear path. The Tabbies, who underwent several personnel changes in the off-season, showed why they might surprise in the North Division as they handed the hometown 'Riders a convincing 37-16 loss. Hamilton K Paul Osbaldiston opened the scoring with 2 consecutive FG from 13 and 48 yards out giving them a 6-0 lead after one. Osbaldiston was at it again as he connected on a 12-yard chip shot 2:43 into the second quarter. Sask, QB Tom Burgess then hooked up with WR Elbert Turner for a 9 yard TD. The Dave Ridgway convert narrowed the gap to just 2. Less than a minute later however, the Tabbies struck again as newcomer QB Anthony Cavillo found WR Earl Winfield all alone for a 17-yard TD pass. Osbaldiston added the convert with 1:19 remaining in the second quarter. Ridgway gave the 'Riders some momentum heading into the locker room by kicking a 20-yard FG with no time remaining on the clock making the score at the end of one-half, Hamilton 16, Saskatchewan 10. Ridgway brought the Green Riders even with 2 consecutive FG's, with the first being a 12 varder at 2:43 and the second was a 41-yard boot with 1:08 left in the third period. The tie was short lived however as RB Kalin Hall took a Cavillo swing pass and went 73 yards for the major. The Osbaldiston convert made it 23-16 after 3 quarters. Hall then put the game out of reach for all intensive purposes, plunging in from 1-yard out. Osbaldiston added the convert at 5:17. The Tabbies rounded out the scoring as FB Lee Knight scored on a 32-yard run at 13:09. The Osbaldiston convert made the final 37-16.

#### FRIDAY, JUNE 30 - BALTIMORE FOOTBALL CLUB 34 AT B.C. LIONS 37 - 23,999

It was the match-up Baltimore football fans had been waiting for since last November. A chance for their hometown heros to go back and prove that last year's 26-23 B.C. victory was a fluke. Unfortunatley, these fans will now have to come to grips that the Lions were for real that Sunday in November and they are for real again this season as they defeated the heavily favoured team from Baltimore 37-34. It was everything it was made out to be as the classic re-match of two evenly matched teams. The Lions got on the board early as RB Cory Philpot carried the ball in from 2 yards out just 3:43 into the opening stanza. Last year's Grey Cup hero, Lui Passaglia added the convert giving the Lions the 7-0 lead. QB Danny McManus put the Leos up by 13 scoring on a 1-yard run. With the Passaglia convert, B.C. now led by 14. Baltimore K Carlos Huerta closed out the first quarter scoring with an 11-yard FG at 13:36, making the score 14-3 at the end of one. RB Mike Pringle narrowed the gap to just 5 at 3:33 of the 2nd quarter, plunging in from 1-yard out. Huerta added the convert making the score 14-10. Passaglia added another FG to round out the 1st half scoring with B.C. on top by a 17-10 margin. Pringle moved Baltimore to within 1 at 2:15 of the 3rd quarter going in from 1-yard out. Huerta's convert tied the game with 12:36 left to play in the third. Philpot notched his second TD of the game, this one a 7-yard TD scamper at 5:24 with Passaglia adding the convert. Huerta and Passaglia then traded FG before WR Shannon Culver hooked up with Tracy Ham for a 16-yard pass and run TD with no time showing on the clock. Huerta's convert made it a 37-27 deadlock after 3 quarters of play. Passaglia connected on a 13-yard FG 7:11 into the final frame. This lead was short lived however as Wright took a Passaglia punt at the 55 and did not look back until he reached the endzone, giving Baltimore a convincing 7 point lead with just 2:42 left to play. With their backs pinned to the wall once again the Lions proceeded to march 38 yards down the field and then with just 15 seconds remaining, Philpot leaped in from 2 yards out giving him his 3rd TD of the game and the Lions the lead. This game marked the first for the Texans after spending the past two seasons in Sacramento. It didn't take long for them to get on the board as QB David Archer scored from 1-yard out 10:30 into the opening frame. K Roman Anderson added his first of 5 converts on the evening, giving the Texans a 7-0 lead. Shreveport replied at the 15:00 minute mark as RB Marcus Patton scored on an 11-yard run. The Bjorn Nittmo convert made the score 7-7 at the end of the 1st quarter. San Antonio DE Roosevelt Collins picked up an errant Shreveport fumble and returned it 18 yards for the major at 7:07 of the 2nd quarter. Nittmo and Anderson traded FG's, before Patton hauled in a 61-yard pass from QB Billy Joe Tolliver with 33 seconds left to play in the 2nd frame. This TD made the score all even at 17 at the end of one half of play. San Antonio then put the game out of reach with back-to-back TD's to open up the third quarter. Gamble scored on a 2-yard pass from Archer and then Archer hooked up with Kralik for a 23-yard major putting the Texans up by 13 at the end of 3 quarters. Anderson added another FG, a 43-yard effort before Brown took the ball in from 23 yards out before Shreveport replied with Scott scooping up a fumble and taking it back 89 yards for the major. After all was said and done, the San Antonio Texans emerged with a 47-24 victory.

## SATURDAY, JULY 1 - TORONTO ARGONAUTS 23 AT EDMONTON ESKIMOS 43 - 27,465

The Eskimos, led by new QB Kerwin Bell, wasted no time in getting on the board in this one as they marched down the field in their opening drive, capping it off with a 1-yard plunge by Michael Soles. The Sean Fleming convert gave the Esks a 7-0 lead 2:53 into the contest. Less than six minutes later Bell hooked up with RB Lucious Floyd for a 72-yard pass and run TD at 8:31 of the 1st frame. RB Reggie Barnes got the Argonauts on the board with just 2 seconds remaining as he scampered in from 13 yards out. The Wayne Lammle convert made the score 14-7 in favour of the Eskimos at the end of 1 quarter. The Argos pulled even at 2:48 of the second frame as Barnes scored his second TD of the game, this one from just 1-yard out. Lammle added the convert to make the score 14-14. Fleming then added a 37-yard FG at 8:58 to re-capture the lead for Edmonton. A Lucious Floyd 3-yard TD run with 24 seconds left on the clock, coupled with the Fleming convert made the score 24-14 in favour of the Esks at the end of one-half of play. P Glenn Harper gave up a 2-point safety at 6:28 of the 3rd-quarter, but this was all of the scoring Toronto could muster as Bell went on to carry it in himself from 1-yard away at 11:19 to make the score 31-16 at the end of 3 quarters of play.
