The passer given the highest efficiency rating in a week is the player who, during the season to date, has thrown an average of 20 passes per game and has achieved the best combination of pass completion percentage, average gain per pass, low percentage of interceptions and high percentage of touchdown passes. The highest possible rating would be obtained by the player who completed 77.5% of his passes for an average gain per pass attempt of 12.5 yards, threw no interceptios and completed one touchdown pass for every 8.4 passes thrown.

### 1995 GAME REVIEWS - WEEK #2

# TUESDAY JULY 4 - BIRMINGHAM BARACUDAS 38 AT WINNIPEG BLUE BOMBERS 10 - 22,208

22,208 fans packed Winnipeg Stadium for their home opener. With former Blue Bomber Matt Dunigan on the sidelines for Birmingham, they were looking to trounce the 'Cudas for their first win of the season. Birmingham had other plans. In their first ever CFL regular season half the 'Cudas scored four touchdowns and one field goal. Birmingham defensive back Andre Strode opened the scoring at 5:34 of the first quarter intercepting a Sammy Garza pass and returning it for a touchdown. Two minutes and thirty-three seconds later QB Jimmy Klingler and WR Jason Phillips connected for a 96 yard passing touchdown. The 'Cudas defense again opened the door when DE Donavan Gans recovered a Garza fumble. With forty seconds left in the first quarter, the 'Cudas capitalized on the turnover and scored their third touchdown of the game. CB Junior Thurman continued Birmingham's domination on defense by intercepting a Garza pass and returning it 61 yards for a touchdown. K Franco Grilla, who had already converted all four Birmingham touchdowns, finished off the first half scoring binge with a twenty-three yard field goal at 14:23. Winnipeg managed to get on the board 4:06 into the second half with a 39 yard Troy Westwood field goal. Toronto head coach Mike Faragalli told fans his Argonauts would win the game or they would be given free tickets to their Labour Day match against San Antonio. At game time it looked like a win might be hard to come by with starting quarterback Kent Austin out with a pulled calf muscle. However, fans looking for the free tickets were disappointed as the Argos came out ahead of the Eastern Riders 37 to 24. Ottawa got on the board first late in the first quarter when QB Danny Barrett threw a nine yard pass to RB Michael Richardson. The Argos opened the second half with a 61 yard touchdown bomb from QB Erik White to WR Darrick Branch. RB Reggie Barnes broke the tie with a 2 yard touchdown run. With 2:05 left in the first half Wayne Lammle, who converted both Argo TDs, split the upright from 34 yards out to give Toronto a 17-7 lead. # TURDAY, JULY 8, 1995 - BIRMINGHAM BARRACUD AS 13 AS AT HAMILTON TIGER-CATS 31 - 23,042

It was the home season curtain raiser at Ivor Wynne Stadium in Hamilton and the 23,042 rabid fans in attendance went home happy as their hometown Tabbies defeated the Barracudas by a 31-13 score. A Franco Grilla single and Paul Osbaldiston 51-yard FG was all the 1st quarter scoring before things opened up in the second. At 4:40 of the 2nd period, QB Jimmy Klingler hit WR Marcus Grant a 86-yard TD pass. The Grilla convert gave the 'Cudas their only lead of the game. Just under 4 minutes later, Hamilton QB Anthonly Calvillo scrimmaged from Birmingham's 10-yard line and found a wide-open SB Frank Marof. The Osbaldiston convert made the score 11-10. Osbaldiston widened the gap with a 29-yard FG at 12:04. Hamilton, for all intensive purposes, put the game away as WR Earl Winfield hooked up with Calvillo for a 5-yard TD pass. Osbaldiston once again added the convert making the score 21-10 at half-time. The two teams traded third quarter FG's before RB Kalin Hall scored his only TD of the game, a 1-yard plunge. The Osbaldiston convert made the final 31-13 in favour of Hamilton upping thier record to 2-0 and dropping the Barracudas to 1-1.

# SATURDAY, JULY 8, 1995 - SAN ANTONIO TEXANS 24 AT BALITMORE STALLIONS 50 - 31,016

It was a historic evening at Baltimore's Memorial Stadium last week. For starters it was the first game for Baltimore fans to cheer on the Stallions and it also marked the first visit for the Texans to Maryland. In the end, it was the Stallions prevailing by a 50-24 score. The two teams traded FG to open up the game and then at 3:22 of the 2nd quarter, Baltimore K Carlos Huerta added his second of five FG on the day, this one from 14 yards away. San Antonio captured their only lead on the day as QB David Archer hooked up with RB Mike Saunders for a 46-yard passing TD. The Roman Anderson convert made the score 10-6 in favour of the Texans. This lead was short lived however as Stallion QB Tracy Ham and WR Robert Clark connected for a 18-yard TD at 10:40 of the second. Just over three minutes later, Ham found WR Chris Armstrong alone in the end zone for a 26-yard major. Huerta's convert made the score 20-10 in favour of the Stallions. Baltimore was not done there as DB Chris Wright corralled a punt and returned it 69 yards for the score with just 45 seconds remaining in the half. The half-time score read, Baltimore 27, San Antonio 10. A Carlos Huerta 38-yard FG opened up the second half scoring before the Texans replies with Saunders scoring his second TD of the game, this on a 1-yard run. The Anderson convert trimmed the Stallions' lead to just 13. Ham then put the game out of reach for good going over from 1-yard out at 13:12 of the 3rd quarter. Huerta opened up the 4th quarter scoring with a pair of FG's (51 and 28 yards). Clark then rounded out the Baltimore scoring snagging a 5-yard Ham pass for his second major of the day 14:35. San Antonio scored on the final play of the game as Kralik hauled in a 27-yard pass from Archer for the major.
