WEDNESDAY, AUGUST 9 - EDMONTON ESKIMOS 31 AT TORONTO ARGONAUTS 10 - 14,192

The Edmonton Eskimos played the first of two games this week Wednesday night in Toronto at the Skydome. Coach Lancaster's high powered defence came in hoping to shut Toronto down in order to move into a tie for second in the Northern Division with the B.C. Lions. A penalty filled first quarter saw very little scoring. Newly acquired punter\kicker Terry Baker scored a single after sending a 30 yard field goal attempt wide. Edmonton countered just before the quarter ended with Sean Fleming making a 45 yard field goal. Edmonton dominated the second quarter scoring 19 points. Punter Glenn Harper sent a 48 yard punt into the endzone for a single. Fleming's second field goal of the night was off the mark but he scored a single as the ball went through the endzone. The Edmonton offence capitalized on a interception by Darian Hagan. RB Michael Soles carried the ball in from the 2 yard line for the first touchdown of the game. Fleming kicked the convert. After missing his first two, Fleming was out to redeem himself on his third field goal attempt. He succeeded, hitting from 22 yards out. Torontos' only points of the quarter came as Edmonton punter Glenn Harper took the ball into his own endzone and conceded the safety. Edmonton got one more touchdown before half-time when they brought in DE Malvin Hunter to carry the ball in from the 1 yard line. Fleming's convert gave Edmonton a 22 to 3 lead going into the locker room for half-time. Edmonton continued to put points on the board in the third quarter. Fleming missed his third field goal, but again, scored a single point. Harper sent another punt into the Toronto endzone to score a single. Toronto's defence got on the score sheet as LB Don Wilson intercepted a Chris Vargas pass and ran it back 23 yards for the major. Baker kicked the convert. The final scoring of the game came late in the third quarter. Soles capped a drive with a 6 yard touchdown pass reception from Bell. Fleming's convert gave Edmonton the lead 31 to 10 which they held through the fourth quarter.

WEDNESDAY, AUGUST 9 - B.C. LIONS 43 AT SASKATCHEWAN ROUGHRIDERS 25 - 20,421

The B.C. Lions first game of a three game road trip had them at Taylor Field in Regina to play the Roughriders. High winds plagued this game giving the team with the wind a strong advantage. Strong running games by Sean Millington and Cory Philpot gave B.C. the edge. B.C. opened the scoring as Saskatchewan punter Brent Matich conceded a safety. This same scene repeated itself two minutes later giving B.C. an early 4 to 0 lead. All-time CFL points leader Lui Passaglia added to his totals by hitting a 45 yard field goal. Later in the quarter, Millington ran in the first of two touchdowns for the night from the 1 yard line. Passaglia's convert rounded out scoring for the quarter. Tolliver in a game that also included two of the Leagues top defensive tacklers - Hamilton's Mike O'Shea and Shreveport's Ben Williams. Hamilton opened the scoring on their first drive of the game. Taylor threw an 8 yard pass to Kalin Hall to cap a 9 play drive. Paul Osbaldiston kicked the point after. Shreveport came right back on the following series scoring on a 5 yard TD pass from Tolliver to Wayne Walker. Nittmo's convert attempt was good. With time running out in the first quarter, Osbaldiston gave Hamilton the lead by kicking a 34 yard field goal. Junior Smith put points on the board for Shreveports' special teams.
