1996 GAME REVIEWS - WEEK #2

Wednesday, July 3

SASKATCHEWAN ROUGHRIDERS 29 at OTTAWA ROUGH RIDERS 14 - 10.125

The first of two meetings between the Eastern and Western 'Riders saw the visitors from Saskatchewan head home with their first win of the season. Kicker Paul McCallum put Saskatchewan on the score board early with a 22 yard field goal following a 10 play, 60 yard drive. The Western 'Riders put another solid drive together on their next possession. McCallum, again, capped this drive with a 36 yard field goal. Ottawa battled back to take the lead on their next possession. Rookie SB Joseph Rogers caught a 16 yard pass from David Archer to tie up the game. Wayne Lammle's convert gave the Eastern 'Riders their only lead of the game. Saskatchewan continued to count on the leg of Paul McCallum in the second quarter. McCallum's third field goal of the game, this time from the 39 yard line, gave the green 'Riders the edge by 2. McCallum was called upon twice more in the second quarter making field goals from 31 and 16 yards out to extend Saskatchewan's lead. At half time, Ottawa trailed 15 to 7. At 4:02 of the fourth quarter, following a scoreless third, Saskatchewan padded the margin when Robert Mimbs completed a long drive with a 2 yard run for the major. McCallum kicked the convert. Archer countered for Ottawa with his fourth touchdown pass of the season, this time over 25 yards to Robert Gordon. Lammle made the convert for Ottawa. With only 1:08 left to play, Saskatchewan running back Peter Tuipulotu put the game out of reach. His 2 yard touchdown run and McCallum's convert put the Western 'Riders ahead 29 to 14 sealing the victory and bringing Saskatchewan's record to 1 and 1.

Thursday July 4

HAMILTON TIGER-CATS 38 at TORONTO ARGONAUTS 36 - 26.333

More than 26,000 fans packed Toronto's SkyDome to watch arguably the two best quarterbacks in the CFL today. They were not disappointed as the game was not decided until time had run out on the fourth quarter. Matt Dunigan and Doug Flutie threw for 795 yards combined. Toronto opened the scoring at the mid-point of the first quarter when Flutie threw a 30 yard pass to Jeff Fairholm. Mike Vanderjagt kicked the convert. Hamilton fought right back moving down field and scoring less than 2 minutes after Toronto's TD. Dunigan connected with Mac Cody on an 11 yard play for the major. Paul Osbaldiston converted the play. The Argos took the lead once again early in the second quarter. Flutie hooked up with Tyrone Williams for a 22 yard passing touchdown. Vanderjagt's convert put the Argos up by a TD. Hamilton's next possession brought them a little closer to Toronto. Osbaldiston kicked a 47 yard field goal for the 'Tabies. The Tiger-Cats took their first lead of the game minutes later. Dunigan threw a 34 yard touchdown pass to Marcus Grant to move ahead of the Argos. Osbaldiston kicked the convert. Toronto and Hamilton exchanged TDs before the end of the half. The Argos scoring on a 20 yard pass from Flutie to Williams and the Ti-Cats on a 22 yard pass from Dunigan to Earl Winfield. Hamilton led by 3 at half-time. The air show did not stop for Hamilton in the third quarter. Dunigan opened the second half scoring with a 24 yard touchdown pass to Cody. Osbaldiston kicked the convert. Hamilton's defence stumped the Argos in the third. Toronto scored a single on a 45 yard Vanderjagt missed field goal attempt and scored three when Vanderjagt hit a field goal from 33 yards out. Toronto had a chance to tie the game with no time left on the clock but the Hamilton defence forced Vanderjagt to attempt a 50 yard field goal. The ball went wide giving the win the visiting Tiger-Cats. This age old rivalry again presented a classic football game.

Friday July 5

MONTREAL ALOUETTES 13 at EDMONTON ESKIMOS 16 - 26,211

Montreal and Edmonton battled a treacherous field following a brief but torrential downpour. The rain and wet grass made for a low scoring game. The Alouettes first got on the board with no time left in the first quarter. Terry Baker made a 36 yard field goal to give Montreal a 3 point lead. Edmonton kicker Frank Jagas had a chance to tie the game late in the second quarter. His 26 yard field goal attempt from the slippery turf missed but did score a single. With only 0:29 on the clock in the second quarter, Edmonton scored the first major of the game. Tony Burse carried the ball in from the 2 yard line for the Eskimos. Jagas kicked the convert giving Edmonton a 5 point lead at the half. Punter Glenn Harper added a single to this lead early in the third with a 50 yard punt into the Montreal endzone. Montreal fought back with a long drive that included recovering a fumble on a punt return by Michael Soles. Jimmy Kemp capped the drive carrying the ball in from the 1 yard line for the score. Jagas' convert attempt missed the mark. Montreal made some of the points up scoring on a 28 yard field goal by Terry Baker but could not get the ball back from the Edmonton offence for a chance to tie the game. Edmonton sent a soggy crowd home happy with a fourth quarter victory over the Alouettes.

Saturday July 6

B.C. LIONS 22 at WINNIPEG BLUE BOMBERS 25 - 25,416

Winnipeg's home opener saw the Blue Bombers pull off a last minute win over the B.C. Lions. B.C. scored first when Andre Strode intercepted a pass from Kent Austin on the Winnipeg 35 yard line and ran it in for a touchdown. Lui Passaglia kicked the convert. Winnipeg put a single on the board early in the second when Bob Cameron sent a punt 73 yards into the B.C. endzone to Clarence Verdin who conceded the point. B.C. extended their lead in the second as Passaglia kicked three field goals before the end of the half. The kicks came from 32, 27, and 34 yards out. Winnipeg came out strongly after the half-time break. Austin hit Dean Lytle with a 12 yard touchdown pass on the 'Bombers first possession. Troy Westwood's convert attempt was good. B.C. scored next as Passaglia hit his fourth field goal of the game. This attempt came from 37 yards out and put the Lions in the lead by 11. Winnipeg managed to get 3 points closer the B.C. mid way through the third quarter. Westwood kicked a 21 yard field goal. Both teams were scoreless until the 10:24 mark of the fourth quarter. Michael Richardson took advantage of a pass interference call on the previous play carrying the ball in from the 1 yard line for the major. Trailing by 2, Cal Murphy kept his offence in to try the 2 point convert. Austin and Gerald Wilcox connected to tie the game with less than 5 minutes to play. With Chris Vargas in the game at QB, the Lions moved the ball into Passaglia's field goal range. Passaglia came through again hitting a 12 yard field goal to take the lead. Not to be out done, Winnipeg drove the ball back up field leaving Westwood a 47 yard FG attempt to tie the game. With only 0:27 on the clock, Westwood's attempt split the uprights. B.C. took possession on their 35 yard line and got stalled by a strong Winnipeg defence. A sack by Angelo Snipes and an incomplete pass by Ware left Passaglia to punt. His attempt was blocked by K.D. Williams and recovered by Leonard Jean-Pierre. The Bombers had a chance to win the game with only 0:04 on the clock. Westwood's 41 yard attempt again split the uprights sending the 25,000 fans at Winnipeg Stadium into a frenzy.
