1996 GAME REVIEWS - WEEK #4

Wednesday, July 17

OTTAWA ROUGH RIDERS 4 at TORONTO ARGONAUTS 34 - 17,288

CFL scoring leader Mark McLoughlin kicked the convert. Hamilton got on the board in the first by means of a 63 yard punting single by CFL punting average leader Paul Osbaldiston. McLoughlin extended the Stamps' lead before the end of the first quarter with a 24 yard field goal. McLoughlin again got the call early in the second and capitalized with a 29 yard field goal.
